


Field nationally representative surveys of U.S. adults who are currently enrolled in Medicare




Conduct in-depth qualitative research with Medicare enrollees to understand coverage, utilization, and healthcare experiences


Men v. women




Lower-income v. middle- and higher-income adults




Under age 65 v. ages 65+




Different racial and ethnic groups




Enrolled in Medicare Advantage v. Traditional Medicare





Employed v. retiree




Different marital statuses




